The above courses are held at the National Centre for Deafblindness, Cygnet Road, Hampton, Peterborough, Cambridgeshire PE7 8FD.

For those with little or no knowledge or experience of deafblindness, we recommend attendance at a Deafblind Awareness session prior to embarking upon the CDC2 course.

Signature (formerly CACDP) is the assessing body for the Level 2 (CDC2) Certificate in Communication with Deafblind People (Manual).

Entry for the Signature assessment is a requirement of attending the CDC2 course i.e. it is not possible to attend the course only. Signature has strict policies over what reasonable adjustments are permitted for the assessments under the Disability Discrimination Act: therefore if you have any concerns over your suitability for the course or assessments or have any specific access needs, please contact the training department prior to enrolment.

Course places are allocated on a first-come first served basis and are confirmed upon receipt of a completed application form.

In order to book Signature assessments, candidates must confirm their attendance by the closing date given. Later withdrawal will incur a cancellation fee as we are unable to substitute candidates for Signature assessments.

Signature has minimum and maximum numbers for candidates taking assessments. Deafblind UK must use the same limits and therefore courses are subject to achieving minimum candidate numbers. Prospective applicants should contact Deafblind UK to verify course dates. We will of course endeavour to keep changes to a minimum but where it is necessary we will give as much advance warning as possible and will seek to offer alternative dates.
