Make your donations worth almost a third more by signing up to Gift Aid today.

Please help **Deafblind UK** to take advantage of the Government's Gift Aid Scheme which allows us to reclaim tax on all eligible gifts from UK tax payers.

When you sign up to Gift Aid, Deafblind UK can recover tax on your donations - making you gifts worth almost a third more at no cost to you! We can claim 25p for every pound you give and until 5 April 2011 HMRC will pay an additional Government supplement of 3p. If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you can claim relief on the difference between the basic rate and higher rate of tax on your donations via your Self Assessment return which you can either retain or donate to Deafblind UK by quoting **QAB62EG**.
